Notice of Action

The future of Treasure Lake depends on you. Every one should do their best for our Five Star Rated Park.

Many of you, the owners of Treasure Lake, are aware that the Park is still operating under the Restrictions prepared for the developer approximately 25 years ago. The members were able to become the owners in 1992 and replace the developer who started the park in 1982.

Due to the recent problems we have experienced with the present Restrictions and By-Laws, the Board of Directors see a need to improve the language, so it is easier to understand and that every owner will have the same rights and be treated equally. The major change we are recommending is a 21-day stay out of 28 days instead of 30. Owners would only have to leave the park for 7 days instead of 9.

We have asked for the assistance of our attorneys to prepare a set of Restrictions and By-Laws that are suitable for the owners and it will replace the developer's old Restrictions and By-Laws. In order to accomplish this task, the owners must VOTE to approve the new Restrictions and By-Laws.

The Board of Directors will be setting up meetings in the near future to answer questions and inform every member of Treasure Lake regarding the changes in the Restrictions and By-Laws. Each member will receive a copy of the Restrictions and By-Laws by mail to read, ask questions and understand the need for these changes. Members will also receive a ballot for voting to adopt the new Restrictions and By-Laws.

We will continue to complete our other objectives for the Park, such as site improvement, more storage, additional and improved rentals, and at the same time improve roads, sewers, buildings and continue to provide quality entertainment that we all expect when we come to our Park for lots of fun and enjoyment. Let's all work hard and enjoy our 25th anniversary.

Rule changes

- A membership can only occupy one campsite at a time – this includes associate members and co-owners
- You can reserve a maximum of 4 rental units
- Rental reservations must be secured with a credit card
- Rental reservations can be made 90 days in advance by owners, 60 days for guests of owners, and 30 days for Coast to Coast and RPI customers. Owners and their guests receive a 25% discount every night, no other discounts are available
- No minimum refund amount for temp storage
- Fishing in Phase 2 pond is restricted to children 18 and under.
- Everyone that checks in must fill out information sheet and turn it in.
