Last year was a difficult time for the Board, with all the personnel changes and three Board members resigning. I surely hope this year will be better.

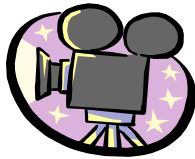

Six-Month Gate Card Program

A Memo from Sam Hartsell

On January 1, 2008, Gate Cards were to be issued only for the duration of a person's stay on Treasure Lake RV Resort. This action was not taken due to not having the Board of Director's approval. On March 31, 2007, the above action was tabled until further notice.

At the last Board Meeting of January 25, 2008, a Six-Month Gate Card Program was implemented to go into effect February 1, 2008 (Exception: March 1, 2008, for Treasure Lake RV Resort owners, residing in Forest Park). Only one Gate Card will be issued per membership card. Gate Cards will be purchased for \$10.00 each and must be renewed every six months, at a cost of \$5.00. A \$5.00 refund will be issued for each returned card.

Gate Cards are not mandatory, as gate slips may be issued at no cost for entry to the Resort. The slip is actually good for one day only and would need to be renewed each day. The Gate Card for the length of stay would still be issued for a \$5.00 deposit, which would be returned when the Owner checks out and turns in their Gate Card.
