Concrete Site Project

The 15 sites that got new concrete pads this year are almost finished. All the concrete is poured, but there is still some block and finishing work to be done. The project has been delayed several times, mostly due to additional work that was added to the project. Several additional retaining walls were built to control water flow and create additional usable space around adjoining sites. We have also had several rain delays (it *is* spring, after all).

The project cost is currently at about \$55,000 with a few thousand left to spend. This puts it on budget when the extra work that was added is taken into account.

Facilities update

For those who don't know, lets go over some new improvements that are completed or underway here at the park:

- The north end restrooms in the Lodge have been completely renovated, complete with new tile, stalls, wall covering, fixtures, etc. They don't even look like the same rooms!
- Four pet rental units have had brand new high quality vinyl floor covering installed – much better for keeping the units clean and looking good
- A five foot safety fence has been installed around the horseshoe pits at the sports complex
- A new water heater has been installed for the indoor pool
- The park's sewer system is being repaired and upgraded on a large scale
- The old rentals in Phase 4 are being removed, and will be replaced with sites
- The air conditioner in the game room has been completely rebuilt
